Friends - it's hard to believe that Americas Latino Eco Festival (ALEF) is well on the way to a fourth successful year. Today minorities make up 40% of the US population but only 13% of environmental organizations, so ALEF's unique contribution to reducing the "Environmental Inclusion Gap," is more important and urgent than ever.

From October 13-15, the 4th Americas Latino Eco Festival will welcome celebrities, artists, scientists, and community and public policy leaders of the Americas to discuss novel solutions in advancing a healthy environment, locally and globally, through advocacy, education, and engagement of culturally diverse populations.

The four themes of this year's ALEF include: People and Forests, Restoration and Public Lands, Acting on Climate Change, and Protecting and Honoring Environmental Leaders in the Americas and around the Globe. This year's regions of honor will be the Amazon and Arctic National Refuge, with Puerto Rico as the country of honor.
